

Affordable. Fast to install.

A temporary PVC roofing overlay that costs less than standard tarps, installs like a typical roofing membrane, and stays clear so the damage underneath is still visible.



Clear enough to inspect through

WHEN TO REACH FOR IT



Right after a storm

Cover exposed decking the same day damage happens, before more wind and rain get in.



While a claim is in process

Stays clear so adjusters, contractors, and homeowners can all see the damage without pulling it back off.



Kept on the truck, ready

Stock it before storm season so you're never waiting on backordered tarps when calls start coming in.



On flat roofs, storm to claim

A temporary overlay for flat and low-slope roofs, keeping storm damage covered while the insurance claim works through approval.

HOW IT GOES ON

- 1 Roll it out over the damage**
Unroll directly over the affected area — no tear-off or special prep needed.
- 2 Mechanically fasten or heat-weld**
Attach with mechanical fasteners, or heat-weld to an existing PVC or TPO roof for a tighter seal.
- 3 Roof's dry, and still visible**
Water's kept out while the damage stays in plain view underneath.

- See-through, so no one has to guess what's underneath
- Installs like a typical roofing membrane
- Keeps the building dry through the claims process
- Costs less than most temporary tarps on the market
- Reinforced scrim for added tear strength
- Rated for up to 8 years of UV exposure
- 20 mil thick, in 10' x 150' rolls
